SBX Performance Academy: Elevating Artistic Excellence

The SBX Performance Academy, a nationally recognized program, offers award-winning arts education led by experienced Shadowbox Live Teaching Artists. As the nation's only STEM-based arts program, our innovative curriculum guides students in discovering and nurturing their artistic talents. Classes culminate in live showcases where students perform alongside professional SBX metaperformers, transforming the stage into an educational laboratory. Through this immersive experience, students explore the process, purpose, and power of art, unlocking their creative potential and developing skills that extend beyond performance. Our unique approach empowers students to grow both on and off stage, setting the foundation for artistic excellence.

Studio 8 Arts Program

During the 8-day theatrical session select high school students discover their true interest in the arts through their first impressions of performing alongside experienced SBX metaperformers, granting them a rare taste of professional artistry and theatrical mentorship. Students have the opportunity to explore the performance disciplines of voice, acting, dance, and music, as well as the primary production arts of lighting, sound, costuming, and backstage. The Studio 8 graduate experience concludes with a production and live showcase performance of a full-length sketch comedy and music show alongside the professionally trained SBX metaperforming artists.

Arts Immersion Program

Designed as 10-day intensive study in truly becoming a working artist, through critical and constructive feedback, students are taught resiliency, perseverance, and poise, readying them for a life in the performing arts. Participants are enrolled in master classes, including vocal, acting, dance, and music performance, while learning critical art support curriculums – arts administration, marketing, and professional development skills. The Arts Immersion graduate experience concludes with a production and live showcase performance of a full-length sketch comedy and music show alongside the professionally trained SBX metaperforming artists.

Artistic American Sign Language Course

This course in collaboration with the Columbus State Community College Interpreter Program applies the cumulative study of American Sign Language (ASL) to the process and purpose of live art. Through the execution of stagecraft and character development, students are challenged to evolve from interpreter to performer and deepen the connection between art and audience. The program culminates with three student interpreted performances of Shadowbox Live's full-length sketch comedy and music show, *Holiday Hoopla*.
